Planes back in the skies

Pilot training at the Point Cook and Bendigo airports has resumed under strict biosecurity conditions.

Instructors and students are only at the airports when flying or debriefing. Each person undertakes a temperature check before entering the premises and must wear masks.



"When we entered lock-down we moved theory classes to a live online platform. For example, our instructor at Bendigo instructs from the hangar as students watching from home. It has been really successful. We've purchased a special sanitiser and cockpits are sanitised between flights," said Mike Heffey, who heads up Flight Training.



"Starting with pilots able to fly solo, we began the phased return on May 11. It was up to each student and instructor as to whether they returned to flying or not."

Students who must fly with instructors are also now back in the skies.
