RMIT Extension Studies

Applications are open now until 15 January 2021.

RMIT Extension Studies allows students to get a headstart at university by completing two undergraduate subjects during the final year of their VCE.

The program will count towards the student's ATAR with up to a five-point boost and as a fifth or sixth subject towards the completion of their VCE. Subjects completed through RMIT Extension Studies also do not incur any fees.

Students who complete the program may get credit towards their future RMIT degree, allowing them to fast track their studies and graduate sooner.

Many of our RMIT Extension courses are offered both on campus and online. If the student lives regionally - or can't make it to campus - they can tailor their RMIT Extension studies course to suit their timetable.

The RMIT Extension program is accredited by the Victorian Curriculum and Assessments Authority as part of their Higher Education Studies program.
